Hunt Valley Rotary Brings Home the Gold!

I was so glad I didn't miss Gettysburg DisCon 2010 because I would have missed seeing President Maria accept the gold award from DG Paul Frey. And it would have meant missing seeing our clubs 4-way speech contestant, Rohan, win the first prize of \$1500. I would have also missed hearing some outstanding speeches.



Mia Farrow was incredible, as she talked about how her privileged Hollywood childhood ended abruptly when she contracted polio at age nine but somehow it was the genesis of her involvement in humanitarian work especially in the worst of all violent places, Darfur, Sudan. I will never forget the faces of the children in the pictures she took, most of whom have lost their childhood due to being brutally raped and seeing family members killed.

Richard King, entertainer, lawyer and past world president of RI lightened up things a bit with his anecdotes but he also moved us to tears as he recounted how he felt for example when a prosthesis was delivered and he watched a young child walk again. He reminded us all that as Rotarians, we are in the “business of people.”

It was a honor to hear from Never Again, Holocaust survivor, Marcel Drimer. who also lost his childhood, forced to crouch in a hole with his family and keep silent for fear of discovery by the Nazi's led to atrophied legs and he had to learn how to walk again once he and his family were liberated. Dr Jim Withers brought us back to the USA and the needs of people that we pass by and often ignore. His experiences of the things he had to do and go through when treating the homeless on the streets of Pittsburg—folks who live under bridges, by the rivers and under cardboard boxes were very funny but not humorous were the diseases and frostbite ailments he treated. He has earned their respect and certainly mine. Since he began his program in Philly other doctors and nurses have started networks of medical services for these disenfranchised people. Including one in California called doctors without walls.

All the speakers were given Paul Harris awards and at each presentation it was mentioned what each \$1000 could buy, i.e. several prostheses, scores of delivery kits etc. Finally, what I took away with me was something that Mia Farrow said which was a common thread throughout all the talks and that was when you learn about something and know it about it you no longer have an excuse not to act.

2010 Four Way Test Program

The Rotary Club of Hunt Valley and The James W. Houck Foundation, Inc. presented the 2010 Four-Way Test Awards ceremony on Thursday, April 22, 2010. The event was held at Loch Raven High School in Baltimore and over 300 students, family members, teachers, and administrators were in attendance.



Over 1000 students from 14 schools participated in this year's program - marking the 42nd year that the contest has been held. Sixty-nine winners were selected from poster, essay, and speech contests, and each winner received a certificate and cash prize.

Rohan Goswani, winner of the Loch Raven HS speech contest was selected as the overall oratorical winner from The Rotary Club of Hunt Valley and represented the club in the District Competition.

We are pleased to announce that Rohan won the District Competition at the finals held in Gettysburg, PA on April 24th and received an additional cash award of \$1500. Congratulations to Rohan and all of the administrators at Loch Raven!
